INTRODUCTION

The number 666. What's it all about? Perhaps no sequence of numbers has ever captured human imaginations more than this one. Most realize intuitively, even if they don't understand its meaning, that 666 refers to something sinister. If you ask the average Joe to explain it, he probably would draw a blank; nevertheless, he would most likely assume it has something to do with the Devil.

When I was a teenager, I remember seeing 666 on the back of a rock 'n' roll album produced by the heavy metal group Black Sabbath. I also remember watching 666 appear under the hair on the head of a young boy in the Hollywood sci-fi film, *The Omen* (1982)—thus identifying this kid as a son of Satan. Rumor has it that 666 appears during dark satanic rituals. It is often scribbled on subway walls

and is embedded in tattoos. Countless books have been written about it, and even today it is discussed by mainstream TV and radio hosts. The number 666 has also been cryptically applied to bar codes on commercial products, and to the U.S. Social Security system.

In July 1976, when the first Apple computer went on sale, its price was \$666.66, sparking heated discussion about whether computers are evil or not.

A friend of mine once purchased a few items at Walmart. As my friend checked out, the total amount of \$6.66 flashed on the screen. The cashier's eyes grew big. My friend blurted out, "Do you know what that number means?" "No!" the employee replied, "but I know it's bad!"

What *does* 666 mean anyway?

Beyond the endless speculation, is there any *truth* behind this intriguing number we should know about? In other words, does the number 666 have any real, practical importance to your life and mine? Or is it all just some whimsical, mythological numéro fiction fit merely for mesmerizing Hollywood movies?

Significantly, this mysterious number appears inside the pages of the last book of the Holy Bible, which is the Book of Revelation. It emerges just one time, in chapter 13, in the last verse. The New King James Version of the Bible translates it this way:

Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it

is the number of a man: His number is 666.
Revelation 13:18.

Believe it or not, the plethora of references to 666 in books, novels, magazines, movies, rituals, Web sites, podcasts, and YouTube videos is generally rooted in the substantive fact that this mysterious number appears inside God's Book. "Here is wisdom," reports the most famous apocalyptic piece of literature ever written. The necessity for "understanding" is highlighted. 666 is then identified as "the number of the beast." The drama deepens when we discover that this same Bible chapter soberly predicts that someday "all the world marveled and followed the beast." Revelation 13:3.

Sounds pretty important, don't you think?

A little reflection should teach us that one reason why Earth's masses will eventually follow "the beast" is because they don't realize "the beast" actually *is* "the beast." In other words, they've been duped by a charismatic Seducer. In fact, if they understood 666, which is *the identifying* "number of the beast," they would be able to detect the deceiver beneath his disguise. But they're clueless. To the world's mesmerized multitudes, 666 is nothing more than an incomprehensible sequence of numbers painted by graffiti artists on subway walls.

The purpose of this book is to decode this mystery. As you journey through its pages, you will discover solid biblical facts about history's most

sinister number. Clues will be pieced together, leading to sensible but shocking conclusions. Finally, the finger of Truth will identify “the beast” itself, which plays such a large role in Bible prophecy. Above all, my goal is to direct your heart to Someone who is infinitely loving and good, whom the Book of Revelation describes as “the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.” Notice carefully:

All who dwell on the Earth will worship him [the beast], whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. If anyone an ear, let him hear. Revelation 13:8, 9.

It is the earnest prayer of this writer that as you read these pages, you will have “an ear” to “hear” its sacred truths. Above all, I hope you will become—if you are not already—an earnest, wholehearted follower of “the Lamb,” who is the Lord Jesus Christ, so that your name will be permanently inscribed in His Book.

CHAPTER 1

FACTS, NOT FICTION

As we’ve already discovered, the mysterious number 666 appears only once in the Holy Bible, inside the Book of Revelation, in chapter 13, verse 18. There’s little doubt that this solitary reference inside the world’s all-time best-selling Volume is the root reason why the number itself has garnered such infamous notoriety worldwide. In this chapter I’m going to put numerous biblical pieces together so you can begin to discern a much larger—and more accurate—picture quite different from what most novels, movies, videos, Web sites, and speculative theories will tell you.

Let’s start by looking again at the “mother text” within the Holy Bible’s last book:

THE 666 BEAST IDENTIFIED

Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666. Revelation 13:18, NKJV.

Upon close analysis we discover:

1. We need “wisdom” and “understanding” to comprehend this topic. According to the Bible, true wisdom and understanding come from God, as it is written, “The LORD gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding.” Proverbs 2:6. The statement that we need “wisdom” and “understanding” implies that we must look beyond shallow theories, focus carefully, think soberly, ponder earnestly, and pray for God’s help.
2. The appeal for us to find “wisdom” and “understanding” also indicates that the biblical message about 666 *can be understood*. If it were incomprehensible, this appeal would not make sense.
3. The number 666 is specifically “the number of *the beast*.” Thus, we must also study “the beast” itself (more on this soon). When we understand what 666 really means, such enlightenment will help us *to more accurately*

discern the true identity of the beast itself.

4. The number 666 is also “the number of a *man*.” When we gain “understanding” about 666, this will help us *to discern the identity of a specific “man”* who is somehow connected to the beast.
5. “His number is 666.” While many Bibles translate 666 as a sequence of three sixes (one six, followed by a second six, and then a third six), the literal Greek text underlying our English Bibles states it differently. Notice how the King James Version, which carefully translates Revelation 13:18 based on the underlying Greek text, puts it:

Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is *six hundred threescore and six*. Revelation 13:18 (KJV, emphasis added).

“Six hundred threescore and six,” states the KJV. The difference is subtle but significant. Follow closely. Three consecutive sixes (6 6 6) would imply that we simply need to locate three consecutive sixes in the right place to identify “the beast” and the “man” associated

with it. But “six hundred threescore and six” is different, meaning that it is not just a matter of locating three sixes in a row (6 6 6), but rather a larger number, “Six hundred threescore and six,” to be exact.

In Old English, a “score” refers to 20 years. That’s what U.S. President Abraham Lincoln meant when during his famous Gettysburg Address given on November 19, 1863, he stated, “Four score and seven years ago our fathers brought forth on this continent, a new nation, conceived in Liberty, and dedicated to the proposition that all men are created equal.” “Four score” means 4×20 , or eighty years. Plus “seven years” brings the total to 87 years. Looking back 87 years from 1863 when President Lincoln gave that speech took his hearers back to 1776 when America first issued its Declaration of Independence from England.

Let’s do the same with “six hundred threescore and six.” First, we have “six hundred.” That’s easy enough. Next, “threescore,” or 3×20 , which equals “sixty.” Finally, adding the last “six,” the exact phrase as written in the Bible should be translated as “*six hundred sixty and six.*” Thus, this phrase isn’t exactly three sixes in a row (or 6 6 6), but rather “*six*

hundred sixty and six.” In other words, we are not looking primarily for three sixes in a row (as in 6 6 6), but rather for “six hundred sixty and six.” The difference is subtle, but, as we will soon see, significant.

6. In the King James Version of the Holy Bible, Revelation 13:18 states that we must “count” in order to reach “six hundred sixty and six.” The New King James translates “count” as “calculate.” Thus, once again, we are not looking just for three sixes in a row (6 6 6), but instead we must do some counting, or calculating, in order to finally arrive at “six hundred sixty and six.”

Don't worry.

I will explain all of this soon.

7. Looking closely at Revelation 13:16, 17, which comes right before the verse mentioning “six hundred sixty and six” (vs. 18), we also discover something else:

He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Revelation 13:16, 17.

Here three separate things are listed: (1) The “mark” of the beast. (2) “The name of the beast.” (3) “The number of his name.” Each is distinct. This book will focus on #3: “The number of his name.” We know from Revelation 13:18 that “the number of the beast” is 666, or more precisely, “six hundred sixty and six.” But Revelation 13:17 provides a new detail that this number is also “the number of his [the beast’s] name.” This critical piece of intelligent information is repeated in Revelation 15:1, 2. Notice carefully:

Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of God is complete. And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over *the number of his name*, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God. Revelation 15:1, 2 (emphasis added).

This passage is similar to Revelation 13:16, 17, yet this time four things are listed: (1) The beast. (2) His image. (3) His mark. (4) “The number of his name.” Thus, twice (once in Revelation 13:17 and again in Revelation 15:2), this mysterious

“number” (which calculates out to “six hundred sixty and six”) is also called “the number of *his name*.” What’s more, “the beast” and its “man” have a specific “name” that we must first identify. Once we find the correct “name,” and then somehow “count” or “calculate” the “number of his name” (which implies taking the name, and then doing some calculating), we will discover that it calculates out to “six hundred sixty and six.” Once we have that information, we can then more fully identify “the beast” itself *whose deceptions we must avoid if we are to follow the Lamb*.

Here is a simple 8-point summary of what we have learned so far:

1. We need “wisdom” and “understanding” to grasp this topic.
2. Thus *it is possible* to acquire “wisdom” and “understanding” about 666.
3. The number 666 is “the number of *the beast*”; thus, we also must understand “the beast” itself.
4. The number 666 is also “the number of *a man*”; thus, we must also understand what “man” is connected to “the beast.”
5. The number of both “the beast” and its “man”

is 666. Or more precisely, *six hundred sixty and six*.

6. To arrive at this “number” we must “count” or “calculate.”
7. This mysterious “number” is also “the number of *his name*.” Thus, we are looking specifically for a certain “name” that belongs to both “the beast” and its “man.” When we find that “name,” and then “count” or “calculate” the letters of “his name,” they will add up to “six hundred sixty and six.”
8. This discovery will enable us to fully identify “the beast” (and the “man” associated with it), to avoid its snares, and to follow more closely “the Lamb” who records the names of His true followers in His Book of Life.

I suggest that you review these 8 points again. Read them slowly. Say a prayer. Ask for wisdom. After you do, brace yourself for a flood of information (in the next chapter) about “the beast” itself. And let me stress again that in order to decode the meaning of the wicked number 666 (“six hundred sixty and six”), we must focus on “the beast,” too.

“What God has joined together, let no man separate,” is a phrase often spoken at weddings

by rabbis, pastors, and priests. According to the Holy Bible, it's the same with the topic of "the beast," its "man," "his name," and "the number of his name," which "calculates" to 666. These are all *linked together*. Therefore, whoever focuses on 666 alone, while avoiding "the beast," its "man," and "the number of his name," is divorcing what God Himself has inseparably bound together.

Again, say a prayer.

Then turn the page.

CHAPTER 2

BEASTS, HORNS, CLUES

“Our whole life is solving puzzles.”

As with the mysterious number 666, endless speculation also exists over the identity of “the beast” itself. When Barack Hussein Obama was the 44th president of the United States of America (2009–2017), he was often driven around in a black limousine nicknamed “The Beast.” As one person commented under a YouTube video about President Obama’s car, “All of this was already written in the Bible.” “The Beast rides in the beast!!” wrote another.*

It’s time once again to separate facts from fiction. But first, a critical point must be made. As you now know, 666 (“six hundred sixty and six”) appears only

once in the Holy Bible, in Revelation 13:18. But we must never forget the obvious fact that verse 18 follows verse 17, which follows verse 16, which follows verse 15, etc. My point is this: The verse about 666 does not appear in isolation from the context of the entire chapter of Revelation 13. Rather, it is the capstone of what had been written before it. As stated previously, it is “the number of the beast,” which means it is the number of *the biblical beast* so clearly described throughout the *entire* prophecy of Revelation 13.

What does the Book of Revelation teach about “the beast”? Let’s find out by doing some sleuthing—by looking at the prophetic clues that Inspiration has provided. At the beginning of Revelation 13, the New King James Version renders John’s words:

Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name (verse 1).

Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like the feet of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne [or “seat,” KJV], and great authority (verse 2).

And he [the beast] was given a mouth speaking

great things and blasphemies . . . (verse 5).

It was granted to him [the beast] to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation (verse 7).

All who dwell on the Earth will worship him [the beast], whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world (verse 8).

If anyone has an ear, let him hear (verse 9).

That's a boatload of information, of which most people who speculate about 666 are wholly ignorant. Not only that, but most fail to realize that Revelation 13 (which is in the New Testament) perfectly parallels another Old Testament chapter which speaks about the exact same things—as a key fitting into a lock. That Old Testament chapter is found in the book of Daniel. It is chapter 7. Carefully notice the parallels. In Daniel 7, God's prophet wrote:

In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon, Daniel had a dream and visions of his head while on his bed. Then he wrote down the dream, telling the main facts. Daniel spoke, saying, "I saw in my vision by night, and

behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea. And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other” (verses 1–3).

Gazing intently upon those “four great beasts,” Daniel noted:

The first was like a lion (verse 4).

The second was like a bear (verse 5).

The third was like a leopard (verse 6).

The dragonlike fourth was “dreadful and terrible” and had ten horns (verse 7).

As Daniel looked closely at the ten horns on the fourth beast, he continued:

I was considering the [ten] horns, and there was another horn, *a little one*, coming up among them, before whom three of the first horns were plucked out by the roots. And there, in this horn, were eyes like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking pompous words (verse 8, emphasis added).

Concerning this eleventh horn, the little one, Daniel wrote:

I was watching; and the same horn was making war against the saints, and prevailing against them (verse 21).

Significantly, Daniel 7 and Revelation 13 both mention a “lion,” a “bear,” a “leopard,” and a dragonlike creature with “ten horns.” In Revelation 13, this “beast” (which is a combination of the lion, leopard, and bear) has “a mouth speaking great things” and wages “war with the saints.” In Daniel 7, the “little horn” does the same thing! It also has “a mouth speaking great things” and wages “war against the saints.” Therefore, and most scholars agree—whether Protestant or Catholic—that the “little horn” *which Daniel saw* is identical to “the beast” *that John saw* in Revelation 13:1–8.

Therefore, if piecing these prophetic clues together can somehow enable us to correctly identify the “little horn” described in Daniel 7, then we will have discovered the correct identity of “the beast” of Revelation 13.

Now here’s a critical question: What does “a beast” in Bible prophecy represent anyway? A man? A computer? Barack Obama’s sleek black limo? The good news is that we don’t have to guess, for the Holy Bible itself provides a plain answer. In Daniel 7—the chapter that perfectly parallels Revelation 13—a holy angel appeared to Daniel in his dream and explained:

“The fourth beast shall be a fourth kingdom on Earth.” Daniel 7:23.

Thus, a “beast” represents a “kingdom” (or

nation) in Bible prophecy. That's settled. Therefore those "four great beasts" represent four mighty kingdoms that would rise and fall on the stage of world history.

In Daniel 7, the first beast was "a lion" with "eagle's wings" (verse 4). Daniel was a Jewish official living inside the kingdom of ancient Babylon (verse 1); and in fact, archeology has revealed that a winged lion was a symbol of that ancient power. Most scholars agree that the lion represented Babylon, which was later conquered by the Persian Empire (symbolized by the bear), which was later defeated by the Greek Empire (symbolized by the leopard) led by Alexander the Great, which in turn was absorbed by the tyrannical Roman Empire (symbolized by the ferocious dragonlike beast).

Visit any library. Study history. These are facts. It's also a fact that the classic date for the fall of the Roman Empire ruled by the Caesars is A.D. 476. Rome finally imploded because it was invaded, weakened, and later divided by ten people groups which swept down into Europe from northern territories—the Vandals, Heruli, Ostrogoths, Visigoths, Franks, Anglo-Saxons, Suevi, Burgundians, Lombards, and Alemanni.

Now, notice carefully the following eight prophetic clues about that mysterious "little horn" described in Daniel 7 which, as we have already noted, *is the same power* (it does the same things) as "the beast" of Revelation 13:1–8 whose "number"

is 666 (“six hundred sixty and six). The “little horn” in Daniel 7 would:

1. Rise out of the fourth beast, or Roman Empire (verses 7, 8). Thus, it would be specifically *a Roman power*.
2. Rise “among” the ten horns—which pinpoints its location in Western Europe (verse 8).
3. Rise into greater power “after” the “ten horns” (verses 8, 24) had settled in their places—that is, after A.D. 476 (the classic date for the fall of the Western Roman Empire).
4. Uproot “three of the first horns,” plucking them out “by the roots” (verse 8).
5. Have “eyes like the eyes of *a man*” (verse 8, emphasis added). Thus, “a man” is associated with this horn. Don’t forget this; for remember, there is “a man” connected with “the beast” and “the number of his name” which calculates out to “six hundred sixty and six.”
6. Have “a mouth speaking great things” (verse 8). It would be exceedingly boastful, making astounding claims for itself.
7. Make “war against the saints” (verse 21).

Thus, it would persecute God's Church.

8. It would continue throughout history, all the way until the day of "judgment . . . and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom" (verses 21, 22).
