MESSAGES FROM HEAVEN

Does God exist? If He does, why does He allow so much pain to occur on His earth? Why is there so much confusion in the religious world?

People even kill in His name.

Believe it or not, God **does** exist, and He witnesses the heartaches we daily endure. **"His understanding is infinite."** Psalm 147:5. When we suffer, He suffers too, just like parents suffer when their children cry. He will also hold accountable those who speak lies in His name. **"A false witness will not go unpunished, and he who speaks lies shall perish."** Proverbs 19:9

To discover the inside scoop of what the King of the Universe is really thinking and saying to our mixed-up world in these **"last days"** (2 Timothy 3:1) find a Bible and turn to Revelation 14:6-12. There you will read about three mighty angels loudly proclaiming messages to earth's inhabitants before God judges the world and abolishes sin. These messages are just as serious as when Noah predicted an approaching, catastrophic global flood (see Genesis 6-8; Matthew 24:37-39). Yet these warnings come from a heart of love, for **"God is love."** 1 John 4:8

Angel One

Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water." Revelation 14:6,7

Angel One proclaims **"the everlasting gospel"** which is the good news of what Jesus Christ, the **"Savior of the world"** (1 John 4:14) triumphantly accomplished for each of us when He unselfishly **"died for our sins"** on a cruel cross, and rose from the dead (1 Corinthians 15:1-4). If we are willing to humble ourselves, pray, confess our sins to God, and trust Jesus, He will freely forgive us, give us His Holy Spirit, and grant us eternal life (see 1 John 1:9; Acts 1:8; John 3:16).

Resting on this solid foundation, Angel One notifies us that Judgment Day is at hand and urges us to **"worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water"**—which is a direct quote from Number Four of the Ten Commandments which states:

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy... the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God...For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it. Exodus 20:8-11

Check a dictionary. Ask a Jew. The "seventh day" is Saturday, **not Sunday**—which is merely "the first day of the week" (see Mark 16:1,2,9; Luke 23:56; 24:1).

In an age where millions have been falsely taught that humans evolved from molecules and monkeys, God wants us to **"Remember the Sabbath day"** and acknowledge that He is the Source of our existence. He made us. He is God. We are not. Thus we owe Him our love and loyalty.

Angel Two

Another angel followed, saying, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication." Revelation 14:8

The word, **"Babylon,"** signifies confusion (see Genesis 11:9) and represents religious organizations around the world that teach confusing errors and lies (like Sunday sacredness) contrary to God's Word.

Sometimes error is promoted in the name of God's love and grace, but it is often a watered down version of love which becomes permissive of sin. True love—which should be our response to what Jesus accomplished for us on the cross—will motivate us to keep the Ten Commandments, not break them (see John 14:15; Rom. 3:20, 7:12, 8:4; James 2:8-12; 1 John 2:4, 3:4, 5:3).

Angel Three

Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand, he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name. Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus." Revelation 14:9-12

The Third Angel's Message is an urgent warning about an approaching just judgment upon all who keep breaking God's law of love (see Romans 7:12; 13:10).
